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## FIELD VISIT KWALITY BREAD FACTORY



Bilal school had organised a Field Trip on 21<sup>st</sup> November, 2017 to Kwaliti Factory located at Andheri, Mumbai which is manufacturers a variety of bread.

A prior information was given to all the students along with the proper instruction so that they can arrive on the proper time, which has been allotted to them.

Today was an auspicious day for all the students who assembled to the school at the given time. The students were so happy and excited for the trip. Students were in proper and clean uniform. Teacher were allotted to take attendance and looking after the students to maintain in discipline and all the students were behaving in a very good manner. The place was filled up with aroma of sweet smell of bread, biscuits, etc. came breezing into our nostrils.

The moment we come out from the bus we had seen the big gates of the factory. After coming out from bus. We entered in to the gate, the teacher once again took the attendance, that all the students were present. Then we crossed the huge tall gates, bearing the factory. Name "KWALITY BAKERY" the students were in the straight line and assembled into the ground, the ground is so big. Then the instructions were given to the students to be in good behaviours.

Then the teachers had divided the students into the pairs according to the classwise. The students and teachers were waiting fell for the person who was taking care after the factory. The man had come he had welcomed us with a warm hearted and introduced himself to us then he told to look around the ground, the information and the boards were displayed there. So he asked and gave us the permission to look about it. The students were so curiously looking about the notice board and laying out rules and advertisement. After seeing all the notice board volunteers had come and they provided us hand gloves and hair mask to the students, and teachers also, because we were entering in the factory.

The puffing and whirring of the machines inside the building could be heard. The way toward the office entrance was occupied on the sides on the by a parking slot, a cylinder bank and a small garden. After climbing a small fleet of stories, we entered a small hall which had many doors to labs, offices, document rooms and a small auditorium. We were shown a presentation in the auditorium about how all the production is made in the factory using an animated video clips.

Then we strolled through the neatly arranged stacks of biscuits, many unknown machines whirring and chunking and reached the end of the corridor, where we the employees explained the making breads dough. The dough was mixed by a huge a machine in the shape of a cart and we were given a sample of the dough to see not to taste, but many of us popped it into our mouth without realising it is not yet cooked. It tasted sweet and good. Then we retraced our steps back to the entrance where there was another door to a huge room where the backing and packing were done.

We saw it other way the packing first then the baking long horizontal stacks of round and rectangle shape at bread made their way to the packing area of robotically on an open tube then pasted itself into seven and the packing machine put them into transparent plastic sheets and into its yellow plastic wrap. The workers took 6-7 packets and covered it with a plastic cover and arranged them in the boxes.

We saw at the entrance. The employees told us that if a packet it not sealed and packed properly, it would be recycled and grinding the materials into powder and adding them to the dough.

Then we moved to the baking areas. The rows of breads in freshly backed, would be seen moving on the conveyor belt into the packing area. Few students look some bread, from the conveyor belt and tasted it. It was not like the packed and stored for months. Breads that we usually eat. This was really hot and tasty and was butter and fresh smoothly pile up the breads, etc. for sometimes; we left the factory by receiving a packet of (small) breads.

The small of sweet returned to us the moment and headed for the buses waiting for us, to be taken back to the school.
