Republic day is an important day for the country because we got our constitution on this day. For celebrating this important day a small program was arranged. Dr. B. R. Ambedkar was appointed as a Chairperson for the committee. It took the constituent assembly two years, eleven months and eighteen days to form the constitution. In January 1950, the constitution's hand written copies were signed by the members of the constituent assembly. After two days, it was declared as the Republic Day. Republic Day is a national festival.

With this short speech of senior inspector the function got over. They shake hands with the children and took photographs with the students. Everybody went back home with information and sweet memories.
